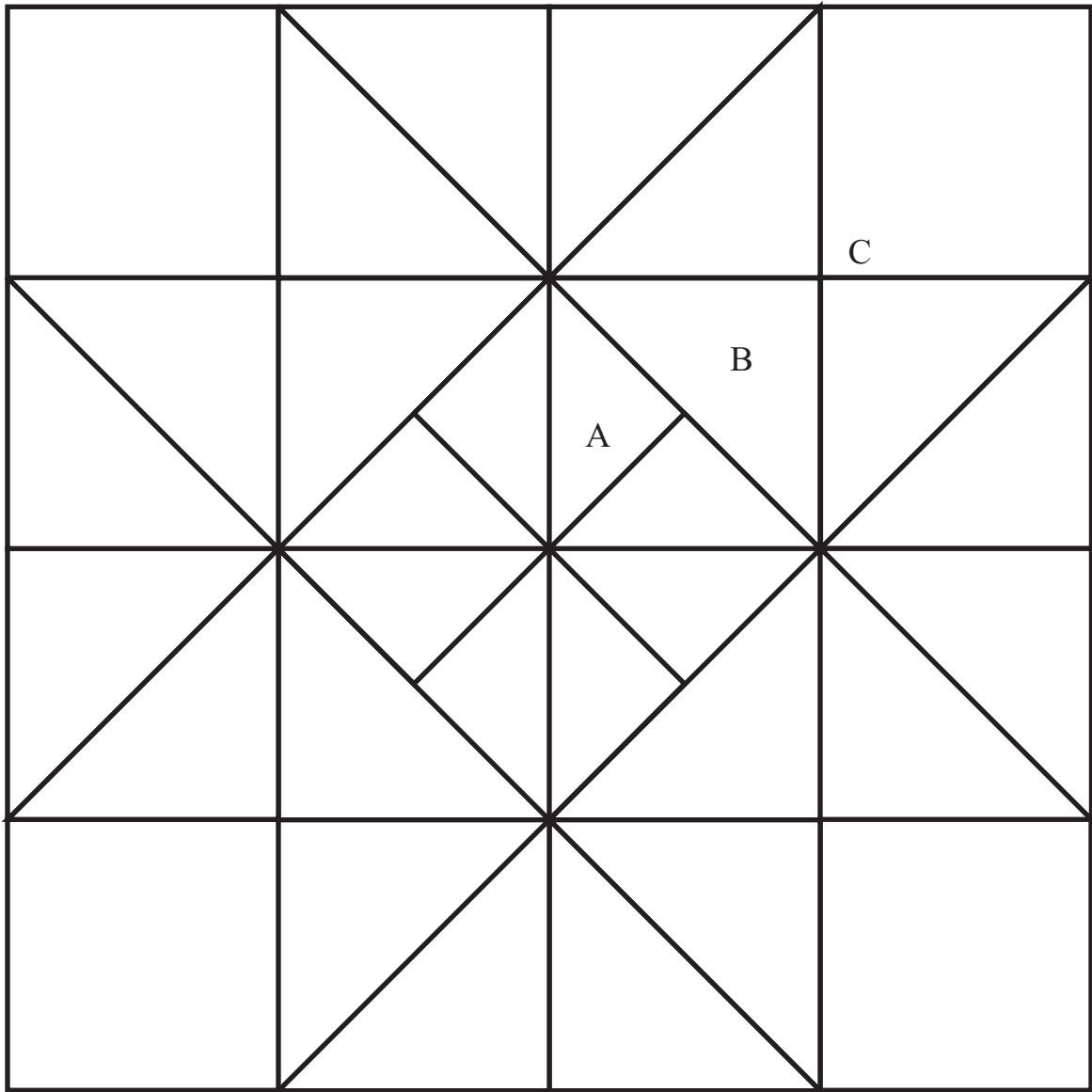
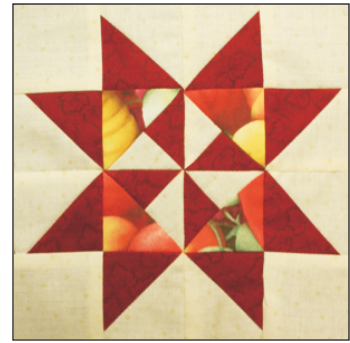

Construction ~

- Make templates for each piece given or use a combination of templates and rotary techniques to cut your block. A cut with template, B $2\frac{3}{8}'' \times 2\frac{3}{8}''$ cut point to point once to form triangles and C $2'' \times 2''$
- This block can be constructed many different ways. I found the best results were achieved by constructing it in four quarters, as in these directions.
- Stitch A triangles in sets of two along a short edge to form

larger triangles. Add a B triangle to each to complete the A/B units – refer to photo for color placement.

- Stitch the remaining B triangles in sets of two.
- Lay out each quarter of the block as a Four Patch. Stitch the B triangle square to a C square and then stitch the other B triangle square to the A/B unit. Stitch the two rows together to complete each quarter.
- Stitch the four units together in the same manner to complete the block.
