



Construction ~

- Make templates for each of the pieces or rotary cut the following shapes from your fabrics. A – $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$, B – $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$, C – $1\frac{7}{8}'' \times 1\frac{7}{8}''$ cut point to point once to form triangles, D – $3\frac{1}{4}'' \times 3\frac{1}{4}''$ cut point to point twice to form triangles and E – $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$
- Stitch A squares in sets of two. To each set add a B rectangle – make four.
- Stitch two C triangles to each D triangle – refer to picture for color and placement. Stitch the C/D segments in sets of two – make four sets.
- Lay out the units created in the first steps with the center E square – three rows of three units. Stitch together the units in each row and then stitch the rows together to complete the block.
