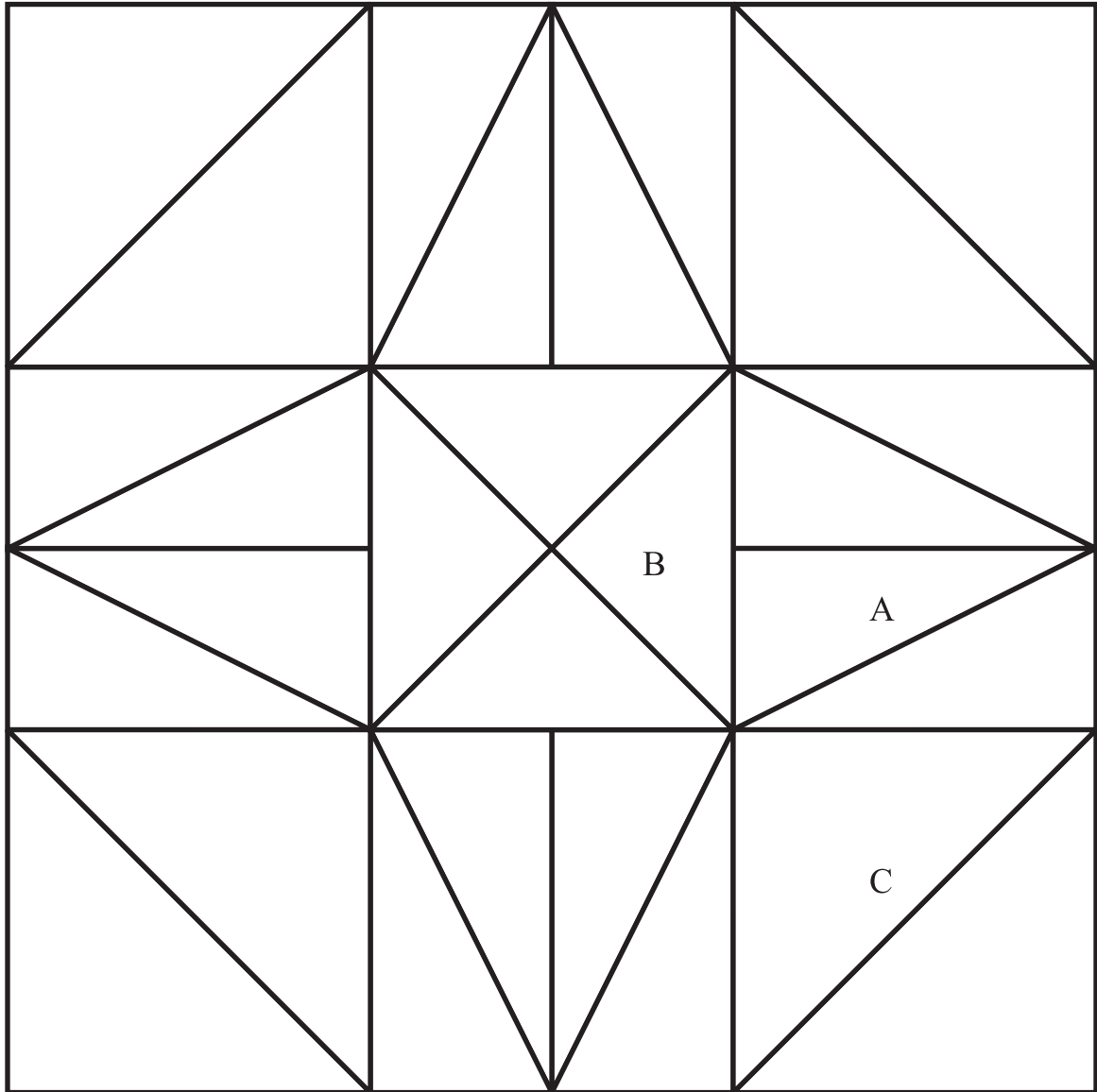


Luscious

Block 22



- Cut A pieces from templates being certain to add $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. B and C may be cut with templates or rotary cutting equipment. To rotary cut - B - cut $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares point to point twice to form triangles, C - cut $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares point to point once to form triangles.
- Stitch the A pieces together to form star points. The most accurate piecing can be done by first stitching together the two A pieces that form the point (and pressing that seam open) and then adding the A background triangle to either side. Stitch four.
- Stitch B triangles in sets of two along short sides of the triangles and then stitch the two pieces together to form the center.
- Stitch the C triangles in sets of two.
- Lay out the block segments in three rows of three pieces. Stitch together first the pieces in each row and then stitch the rows one to the next to complete the block.
