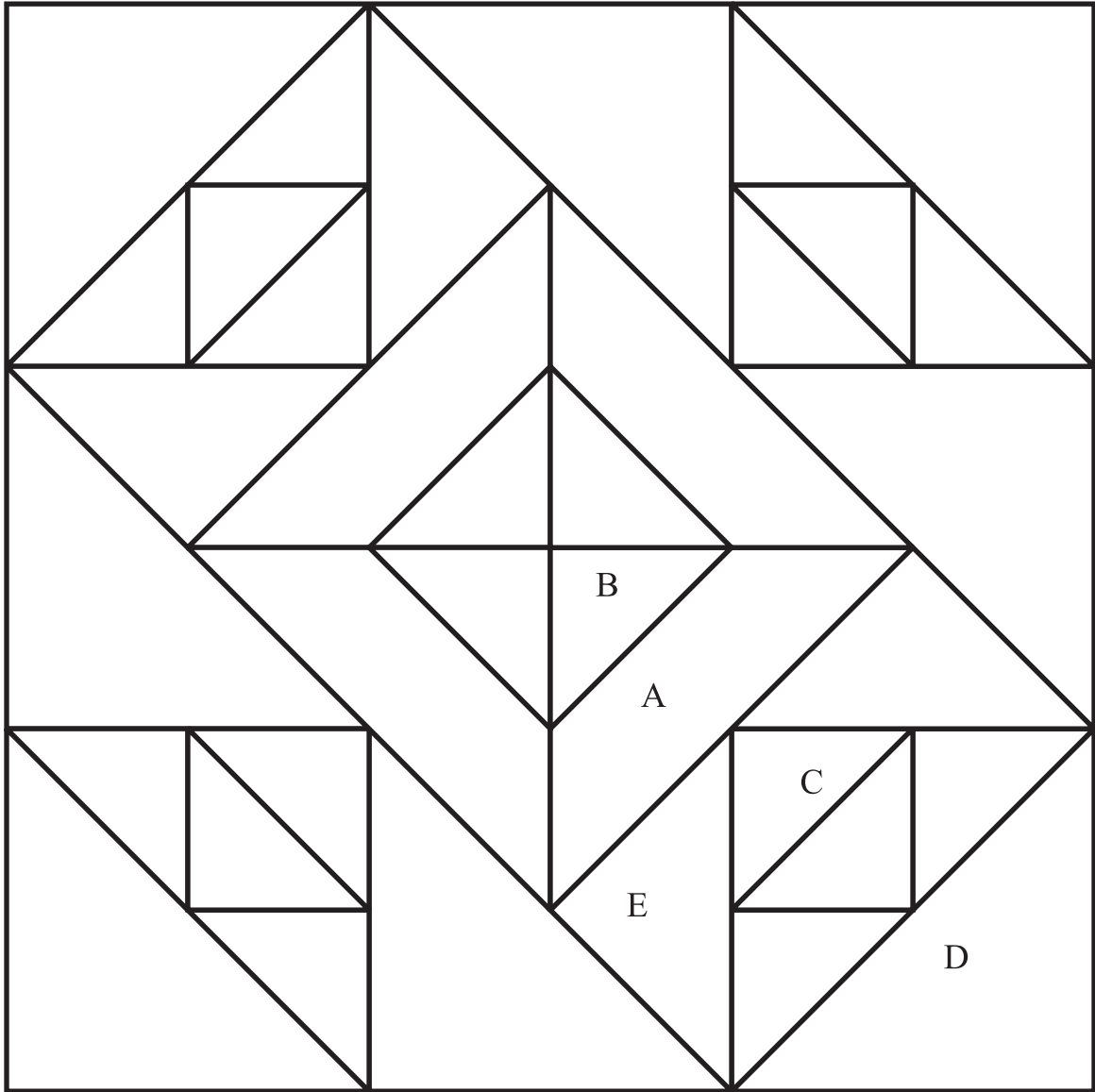

Block 23



- Make templates for all of the pieces or rotary cut the following shapes from your fabrics. A – $2\frac{7}{8}'' \times 2\frac{7}{8}''$ cut point to point once to form triangles, B – $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$, C – $1\frac{7}{8}'' \times 1\frac{7}{8}''$ cut point to point once to form triangles, D – $2\frac{7}{8}'' \times 2\frac{7}{8}''$ cut point to point once to form triangles, E – $2\frac{1}{4}'' \times 2\frac{1}{4}''$ cut point to point once to form triangles
- Lay a B square right sides together on the corner of an A triangle. Stitch point to point on the square, press the piece back to form a small triangle on the larger triangle (trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}''$). Repeat for all four A triangles. Stitch in sets of two and then stitch the two sets together to form the block center.
- Stitch C triangles in sets of three – refer to the diagram for color placement.
- Stitch two E triangles to each of two adjacent sides of two C triangle units. Add a D triangle to the other side of each. Stitch these units to opposite sides of the block center.
- Add three D triangles to each of the remaining C units and then stitch these to the center to complete your block.
